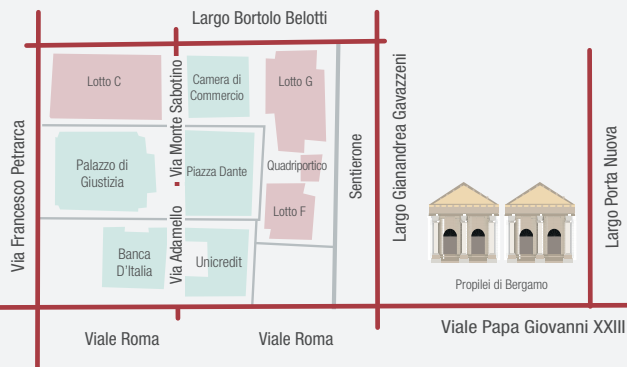

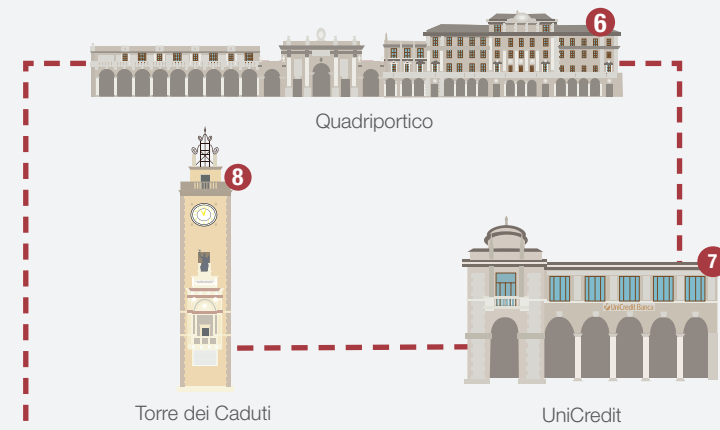
GUIDED TOURS AND ITINERARIES INTO
THE HEART OF BERGAMO





Centro Piacentiniano is the vein of the Lower Town. This architectural complex designed by **Marcello Piacentini** gave the city a new layout. In the beginning of the **1900s** Bergamo decided to rethink the Lower Town through a project whose target was to give a crucial impact to the area that had been until then dominated by a suggestive eighteenth-century Sant’Alessandro Fair. The desire to give a new modern soul to the city of Bergamo led to the proclamation of two contests intended to redesign globally the area which was destined to become a beating heart of life and relationships of Lower Bergamo. The project: **“Visite guidate e itinerari turistici nel cuore di Bergamo”** provides three tourist itineraries thought to reveal the magnificence of Centro Piacentiniano.

By departing from **1. Piazza Dante** and walking around the nearby streets, you can admire buildings designed by the Roman architect Piacentini, such as: **2. Banca d’Italia**, **3. Palazzo di Giustizia**, **4. I Due Cortili**, **5. Camera di commercio**, **7. Unicredit**. By turning towards the iconic **6. Quadriportico**, you overlook the **Sentierone** where the inhabitants of Bergamo use to meet and have a walk and which brings you to **8. Torre dei Caduti** the symbol of the City and the distinctive feature of Centro Piacentiniano.



DEPARTING

from Centro Piacentiniano, the focal point of the modern city, you can choose to visit two historical districts located on the East and on the West side of the old city fair, respectively: **Borgo Pignolo** and **Borgo San Leonardo**. Aristocratic and refined the first one, folk and animated the second one, both imprinted with the centuries-old character they still maintain.
